



**MATTER: PROVISIONAL PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE FILE: 22-  
001917-1027-CA**

**ACTORS: INTEREST IN JUSTICE, DUSTIN [REDACTED] AND XYLIE**

**DEFENDANTS: THE STATE AND THE COSTA RICAN SOCIAL SECURITY  
FUND**

**CONTENTIOUS-ADMINISTRATIVE AND CIVIL COURT OF FINANCE.**

**At fifteen hours and fifty minutes on October nineteenth, two thousand and twenty-two.**

Pursuant to article 23 of the Contentious Administrative Procedural Code and in view of the request for a CAUTIONARY MEASURE INAUDITA ALTERA PARTE formulated in which it is requested **"to suspend the actions of authorization of the pediatric vaccines COVID-19 for populations from six months to five years old, to give the due informed consent and to publish in the Gazette that the therapies based on genes "COVID-19 Vaccinated Products" for use in babies be stopped immediately"**, the requested precautionary measure is rejected on a provisional basis, since, after analyzing the proposed action, the undersigned judge considers that it is convenient and necessary, prior to issuing the definitive resolution of the case, to give a hearing to the parties involved, in order to have the required factual and evidentiary elements necessary for the definition of the proposed matter. Therefore, from the above precautionary measure, the defendants **CAJA COSTARRICENSE DEL SEGURO SOCIAL** and the **STATE** are granted a written hearing for **THREE BUSINESS DAYS**, so that they may pronounce themselves and offer the evidence they deem pertinent. The defendants are warned that in the first written document they submit, they must indicate a means to receive notifications, under the warning that

until they do so, the subsequent resolutions will be notified within twenty-four hours of being issued, including the sentences. ***Jose Ariel Solano Solano, Judge.***
